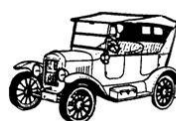
**Christmas Lunch** will be held December 19th at the Ridge.

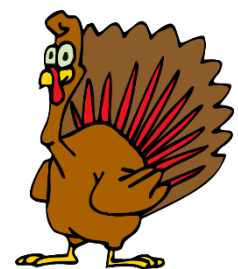

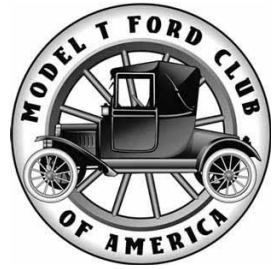
