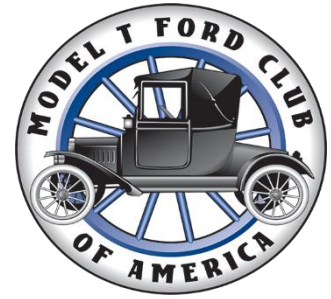

Adjourned with no further discussion at 7:35PM

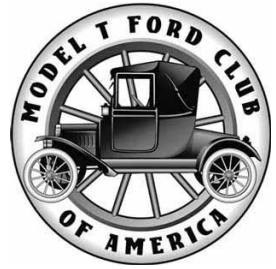
