Mother Lode Model T Club donates state of the art tool to Auburn Fire Department - Traci Newell, The Auburn Journal, Feb 11, 2022 9:00 AM

The Auburn City Fire Department has one more tool in its engines now, thanks to a donation from the **Mother Lode Model T Club**.

Members of the Mother Lode Model T Club were at the Maidu Fire Station on Monday to see first-hand how their donation would be put to use to benefit the community. Their \$2,500 donation went toward the purchase of a new thermal imaging camera for the department.

Battalion Chief Rob Zaucha said the tool provides an image using infrared technology to help show people, hot spots and more in dark spaces or a smoke-filled room.

"We can use this for fires false alarms. It will help us rule out a fire, it will help us find the seed of a fire by showing where the majority of heat is coming from," said Captain Lucas Rogers.

To show an example, Zaucha and his team filled a training hallway with water-based smoke to mimic the difficulty they face when searching for victims in a fire.



"When you look in a smoke-filled room, you anything," can't see Rogers said. "This tool will help us see almost everything. It will help us find a way out faster and help us perform will searches for victims faster."
