#### GROWING UP WITH MY MODEL T'S, #5

I drove my Mercury Model T until about 1930 when I decided to up-grade myself and traded it for a 1927 Star Six Roadster. It was beautiful in its day. It had a tan top, blue body and a rumble seat. It also had a windshield and side wings for the rumble seat and six wire wheels, two on the fender wells. It also had a loud exhaust whistle. I had started to court my late wife about that time. I used to race by her house and blow the heck out of the exhaust whistle. Then I would meet her on the sly at the library as her father had no use for me what so ever. We would meet at the library at nights and take a little ride in the Star. One night I took her out for a little ride but got back a little late. I let her off at the library and went home. About half an hour later the bell rang. I went to the door and here was Pearl, my girl, scared to death. She had gone home and found that her father was out looking for us with a gun. I tried to calm her down but she said if she went home, her father would kill her. Well, we talked a while and then decided to run away and get married. I got the Star out and away we went to San Jose and got married. In the meantime her father was out looking for us with his gun. If he had found us, I am sure I would have been dead, but he didn't find us for about a week and by then he had cooled off. I was 21 and Pearl was 16 years old.
