## My First Model T By John Saylor

I hauled this TT home about 1967, trading a 1929 Graham for it. I felt I was in over my head with the Graham. The TT included the C cab top but not much else. I kept it in a barrowed garage, working on it evenings and weekends. I changed the bands, tightened the rods, and had a radiator re-cored. Found some used tires at a swap meet for the front and

two old truck tires at my Dad's farm for the rear. Then a few pulls on the crank and it was running. Practiced driving up and down the drive way a few times then drove it home. Took it on a tour with the Kern County Model T Club. It ran poorly and sloooow. Over the next few months I purchased a used engine from Mike Bashore, replaced the coils with a distributor, installed homemade upholstery and painted. The TT had a Langbein auxiliary under drive transmission that I reversed internally turning it into an overdrive. With

the 8.00x20 tires on the rear I could keep up with the regular T's. I made a trip to the Long Beach Hill Climb in 1968 and again in 1969. Didn't win anything but had a wild ride towing it home behind my '69 Mustang. Ask Mike about the ride! Later that year I sold the TT and started restoring the '21 Touring. Several years later I received my

Vintage Ford magazine and to my surprise, there was my old TT on the back cover. Picture was taken on the Walton's Movie set.

Now, I need your short story of your T. See that was easy.
